

TIPS FOR THE TAXPAYER

If you worked in 2009, the Federal Government may owe you a
refund on your taxes!

Refunds can be as high as \$5,657!

You may be entitled to an Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) refund if you worked full-time or part-time during at least some of 2009!!!

EITC can be claimed by single adults or married couples who worked in 2009 and:

- earned less than \$35,463 and had one qualifying child live with them for more than six months or \$40,463 for married filing jointly;
- earned less than \$40,295 and had two qualifying children live with them for more than six months or \$45,295 for married filing jointly;
- earned less than \$43,279 and had three or more qualifying children live with them for more than six months or \$48,279 for married filing jointly;
- were between the ages of 25 and 65, had no children who lived with them and earned less than \$13,440 or \$18,440 for married filing jointly.
